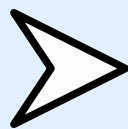

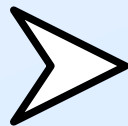

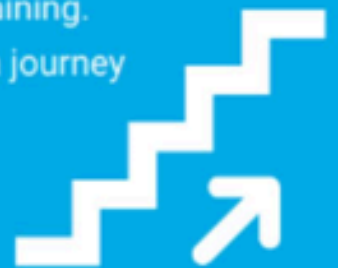

The Together Project at The Mix supports young people aged 15 (Year 11) - 25 onto their next step, whether that be into education, employment, or training. We take a person-centred approach and aim to take young people on a journey to discover their true value and build their confidence.



OUR OFFERS

- 1:1 Coaching with a Youth Worker
- Job Squad
- Employability Skills Workshops
- Work Experience & Volunteering Support

We also run additional groups and courses, such as Diadem, Expression and youth social action projects to support young people with barriers they may have to their next steps.

YEAR 11 SUPPORT



To start an apprenticeship, you'll need to be:

- 16 or over
- living in England
- not in full-time education

You can apply for an apprenticeship while you're still at school but you'll need to be 16 or over and completed year 11 before you can start the apprenticeship.

FREE COURSES FOR ADULTS (19Yrs+)

The Suffolk Adult Learning Service is led by Suffolk County Council and provides a wide range of free Health and Wellbeing, Learning in Families, English, maths and English for Speakers of Other Languages courses (up to Level 2 - GCSE equivalent) for adults, 19 years+, in Suffolk.

The service particularly targets those adults who have missed out on previous educational opportunities or who come from groups with the highest levels of need.

Many of our learners start from very low educational levels, often overcoming many barriers in order to achieve success.

We are a positive force in our community enabling people to enhance their learning and employment goals!
