

Have you ever thought about working with young children?



With a career in the early years you get to nurture, inspire, educate and care for babies and young children.

This can be incredibly rewarding.

The sector is full of opportunities, working full time, term time, part time or even from your own home as a childminder!

What is it like?

The joy and wonder on a child's face from an activity you have provided to support their development is truly rewarding and magical, but working in the early years can be hard work too.

There are **428** preschools, day nurseries, school nursery classes and out of school clubs in Suffolk and **244** childminders. Why not contact your local early years setting to see if you could do your work experience there? It is advised to gain some experience before applying for a college course/apprenticeship.

Qualifications

You can work in the early years up to degree level and beyond. The most common qualification is a level 2 or level 3 in childcare.

You could study

- on a classroom based course at college
- on a <u>T-level course</u> which provides placements in different early years settings
- as an apprentice, working and gaining a wage whilst you train

YEAR 11 SUPPORT



To start an apprenticeship, you'll need to be:

- 16 or over
- living in England
- not in full-time education

You can <u>apply for an apprenticeship</u> while you're still at school but you'll need to be 16 or over and completed year 11 before you can start the apprenticeship.

Skills Bootcamp update:



"Welcome to 2024! The Skills Bootcamp team would like to start the New Year by announcing we have successfully secured DfE funding for Wave 5 (24/25), which opens the door to approximately another 560 learners gaining access to Skills Bootcamps in the coming year.

We are still delivering programmes under Wave 4 and anticipate around 490 learners will complete programmes with outcomes being, gaining employment, new contracts if self-employed or progressing within their organisations to take on more responsibilities.

From April 1st 2024, with the New Anglia Local Enterprise Partnership being dissolved, the Skills Bootcamp team will transition across to Suffolk County Council although delivery of Skills Bootcamps will still be delivered across both Norfolk and Suffolk counties. Procurement will take place between January-March with new Skills Bootcamps commencing early April-May.

The priority sectors still include: Digital, Construction, Technical Core, HGV plus new sectors bring added including Early Years and Creative Industries. Green skills will now be embedded throughout all sectors."

What are Skills Bootcamps?

Skills Bootcamps are part of the Government's Lifetime Skills Guarantee, helping everyone gain skills for life, funded through the Department of Education and are free (to the learner). Driven by employers' needs within our region, the aim is to bridge existing skills gaps and address recruitment needs by providing flexible, intensive training programmes.

Am I eligible?

Anyone who is 19+ in full-time or part-time employment, self-employed, unemployed, or adults returning to work after a break. Learners who are applying independently can access the Skills Bootcamps – fully funded. If you are unemployed, you will be offered a guaranteed interview with an employer at the end of your programme. For employers looking to up skill their existing staff to take on more responsibilities, a small employer contribution is charged. SMEs 10%, larger employers 250+ staff 30%.

Skills Bootcamps last from 60 hours up to 16weeks and have been designed to offer flexible training to work around learners' commitments.

Multiply Suffolk is here to deliver bespoke coaching, training, and mentoring to support you into learning and employment across Suffolk. Multiply Suffolk will provide opportunities for you to improve your knowledge, understanding and use of maths in daily life: at home, in learning and in work.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Age 19+
- Live in a Suffolk Postcode area
- Do not hold a Level 2 qualification or above in Numeracy (GCSE or Functional Skills)

The Multiply Suffolk team can:

- Support to engage with education, employment and training
- Improve numeracy, money management and budgeting skills
- Encourage career progression whilst in or out of employment
- Promote independence, choice and wellbeing
- Empower you to remove barriers to employment and gain a numeracy qualification











Multiply Suffolk support individuals with barriers such as English as a second language (ESOL), care leavers, ex-offenders, learning disability/difficulty and autism, poor mental and physical health. We also support those who are employees, employers, volunteers, and selfemployed individuals.

The Suffolk Adult Learning Service is led by Suffolk County Council and provides a wide range of free Health and Wellbeing, Learning in Families, English, maths and English for Speakers of Other Languages courses (up to Level 2 - GCSE equivalent) for adults, 19 years+, in Suffolk.
