A Massive good luck to all of our year 11s that are in the middle of their exams right now! We couldn't be prouder no matter what the results are.

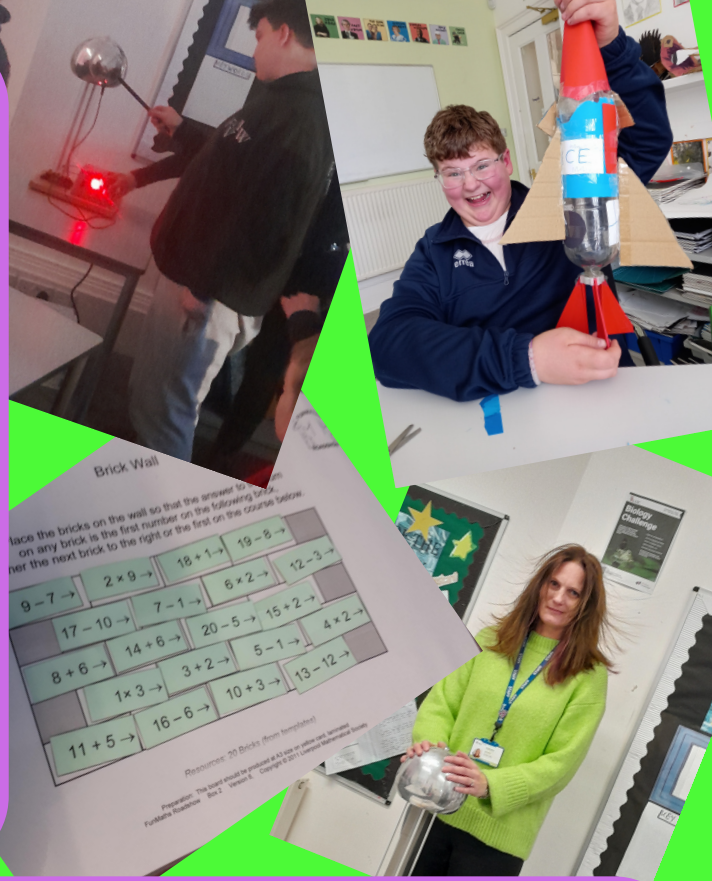
Computing
