<u>Apprenticeships Suffolk</u> <u>Update!</u>

Since its establishment in 2020, the European Social Fund (ESF) funded Apprenticeship Suffolk project has taken forward a range of activities with a main focus on engaging businesses to support the creation of apprenticeship opportunities, creating a talent pool of apprenticeship ready participants and matching participants to appropriate apprenticeship vacancies.

The team have successfully engaged with over 400 participants, supported over 200 SME's and have achieved more than 100 Apprenticeship starts. In order to maintain the momentum of the project, SCC will continue to deliver the Apprenticeships Suffolk project for an initial 12 months post ESF funding.

During that time we will look to both continue and build upon the work and support provided to date. This will include enhancing our focus on supporting those that need it pre-apprenticeship, securing greater employer involvement and identifying additional workstreams that support wider Suffolk County Council priorities.

We look forward to continuing to work with you!



Eligibility Criteria:

- Age 19+
- Live in a Suffolk Postcode area
- Do not hold a Level 2 qualification or above in Numeracy (GCSE or Functional Skills)

- Improve numeracy, money management and budgeting skills
- Encourage career progression whilst in or out of employment
- Promote independence, choice and wellbeing
- Empower you to remove barriers to employment and gain a numeracy qualification











Multiply Suffolk support individuals with barriers such as English as a second language (ESOL), care leavers, ex-offenders, learning disability/difficulty and autism, poor mental and physical health. We also support those who are employees, employers, volunteers, and self-employed individuals.


