

• What is Try a Trade?

We're helping school students in Years 10 and 11 discover more about careers in the trades, providing teachers and career advisers with a hub of resources and content to share as part of your careers programme or careers fairs, as well as first-hand access to people already working in trades.

Try a Trade, powered by Checkatrade, aims to help plug a national trade skills gap of almost **ONE MILLION** workers over the next decade, by connecting young people with a world of limitless possibilities in a trades career.

What to expect

A range of schools across the UK are using Try a Trade resources in their schools to excite and inspire young people about working in the trades. It offers:

Skills Bootcamps



Skills Bootcamps are part of the Government's Lifetime Skills Guarantee, helping everyone gain skills for life, funded through the Department of Education and are free (to the learner).

The aim of Skills Bootcamps is to:

- Provide businesses with targeted and flexible training to upskill their employees so they can gain progression within the business.
- Aid businesses to hire people with the skills required and help fill their vacancies.
- Support individuals to develop skills and fulfil their potential and assist people currently un-employed or returning to work to find skilled local employment.

Skills Bootcamps are open to anyone 19+ who has the right to live and work in the UK.

For individuals and self-employed the training is fully funded. For businesses, there is a small employer contribution:

For small to medium employers (SME) 10%

For businesses with more than 250 employees 30%

Skills Bootcamps are employer led programmes aimed to meet business needs. The training is delivered by our approved training providers, offering flexible training solutions, with many being delivered remotely.

Multiply Suffolk is here to deliver bespoke coaching, training, and mentoring to support you into learning and employment across Suffolk. Multiply Suffolk will provide opportunities for you to improve your knowledge, understanding and use of maths in daily life: at home, in learning and in work.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Age 19+
- Live in a Suffolk Postcode area
- Do not hold a Level 2 qualification or above in Numeracy (GCSE or Functional Skills)

The Multiply Suffolk team can:

- Support to engage with education, employment and training
- Improve numeracy, money management and budgeting skills
- Encourage career progression whilst in or out of employment
- Promote independence, choice and wellbeing
- Empower you to remove barriers to employment and gain a numeracy qualification











Multiply Suffolk support individuals with barriers such as English as a second language (ESOL), care leavers, ex-offenders, learning disability/difficulty and autism, poor mental and physical health. We also support those who are employees, employers, volunteers, and self-employed individuals.



FREE COURSES FOR ADULTS (19Yrs+)

The Suffolk Adult Learning Service is led by Suffolk County Council and provides a wide range of free Health and Wellbeing, Learning in Families, English, maths and English for Speakers of Other Languages courses (up to Level 2 - GCSE equivalent) for adults, 19 years+, in Suffolk.

The service particularly targets those adults who have missed out on previous educational opportunities or who come from groups with the highest levels of need. Many of our learners start from very low educational levels, often overcoming many barriers in order to achieve success.
